The Construction Essentials course is required for all first year apprentices in all trades (carpentry, laborer, plumbing, electrical, operator, masonry, insulating, etc.) as a prerequisite to enrollment in the specific trade course to be offered in Spring 2011 semester. Minimum 11 students

Online training modules: Basic employability skills and Your Role in the Green Environment. (22.5 hrs)*

Classroom training modules: basic safety, intro to construction math and drawings, intro to hand and power tools, basic rigging, basic communication skills and intro to materials handling. (86 hrs)

*Note: Instructor will oversee 5 hours of the student's online progress which also includes performance exams.
