Construction Essentials (Online/Classroom) CE10110

The Construction Essentials course is required for all first year apprentices in all trades (carpentry, laborer, plumbing, electrical, operator, masonry, insulating, etc.) as a prerequisite to enrollment in the specific trade course to be offered in Spring 2011 semester. Minimum 5 students

Online training modules: Basic safety (includes OSHA 10), intro to construction math and drawings, basic communication and employability skills and Your Role in the Green Environment. (62.5 hrs)

Classroom training modules: Intro to hand and power tools, basic rigging, intro to materials handling, First Aid/CPR, Sexual Harassment, Labor Relations, Lead and Asbestos Awareness. (65.5 hrs)

*Note: Instructor will oversee 11.5 hours of the student's online progress.
